## **SCHEDULING PROCEDURES FOR THE AMC CLINICAL EXAMINATION:**

The scheduling of candidates into particular centres is done immediately after the closing date of each Series. Candidates will be notified if they have been successful at gaining a clinical position, approximately ten days after the closing date for the series for which they applied.

Candidates should note that, where the number of applications for clinical examination places in a specific examination Series exceeds the availability of examination places, scheduling will be on a priority basis along the following lines:

- first attempt candidates will have priority over repeat attempt candidates;
- the scheduling of first attempt clinical candidates will take into consideration the time since they sat and qualified at the MCQ examination;
- candidates will be ranked in merit order based on their overall score in the MCQ examination;
- candidates with fewer repeat attempts will have priority over candidates with a higher number of repeat attempts.

Candidates who have been scheduled for a clinical examination may not lodge an application for another Series before they have received the results of the scheduled examination.

### **EXAMINATION FEES:**

Do not send the examination fee with Form C-2. The examination fees for the clinical examinations will be payable when a candidate has been scheduled for the relevant examination session.

Payment of the examination fee will confirm the placement in the relevant clinical examination session. If the examination fee is not paid by the due date, the candidate will not be permitted to sit for the examination.

Candidates who withdraw after accepting a clinical place will incur a withdrawal fee, the amount depending on the date of the withdrawal. ### **ADDITIONAL NOTES:**

All applicants must have satisfied the English language proficiency requirements before they will be permitted to sit the clinical examination.

You may only apply for ONE Series of clinical examinations at a time.

The AMC will send the booklet, ***Examination Specifications Clinical Supplement***, along with your receipt for the examination fee paid.

The AMC will acknowledge receipt of this form within 10 working days.

#### **AMC Clinical Examination - Important Notice**

Australian Medical Council clinical examinations are conducted on specified Saturdays throughout the year, due to limitations on the availability of suitable clinical examination venues.

The AMC is aware that this scheduling of clinical examinations may create difficulties for some candidates due to religious convictions. Candidates who believe that they fall into this category should contact the clinical examinations section of the AMC concerning alternative arrangements for scheduling of clinical examinations in such cases. As alternative venues are very limited, applicants for special consideration in scheduling will be required to submit documentary evidence in support of their case for special scheduling.
